Treasurer's report as of June 30, 2025, there was \$452,184.11 in the bank, including the CD's. Mark motioned to approve the Treasurer's report; Jim seconded. All were in favor, and the motion carried.

Stan, Fort Ripley Supervisor, and Jim, St Mathias Supervisor, discussed the June 23rd information meeting with Crow Wing County. CWC recommended two phases regarding replacing the L3942 bridge. The first phase is to remove the existing unsafe bridge and to start the process. Crow Wing County requires a written resolution from both townships confirming interest in moving forward. Fort Ripley Township proposed revising the drafted resolution to change "responsible" to "potential" in paragraphs 6 and 7. The MAT lawyer will be contacted for clarification.
